This is *the* place to eat in Siena. International businessmen, powerful politicians and movie stars—no one goes to this medieval city without eating at Le Logge. You not only eat well; owners Gianni and Laura Brunelli run their restaurant with style and verve.

For an appetizer, try the Malfatti (the filling of ravioli) or a simple carpaccio. Grilled meats are the best main courses, although there's occasionally fresh fish such as squid salad or roasted sea bass. Mirco Vigni is in charge of the wine list, and knows his stuff. He also speaks excellent English; so ask for him for a recommendation. You might try a bottle of Brunelli's own Brunello di Montalcino. The 1995 is particularly good.
